It has good train connections to Seville and Cadiz and it is also easy to get to the beach – Valdelagrana is the easiest one to get to.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What can the town/neighborhood offer a Language Assistant? Leisure, reading clubs, cinema clubs, language exchange, council/district courses, sports clubs, hiking trails, nature, culture, gastronomy... It would be good to offer the local networks to the language assistant and facilitate his/her integration into them. 	<p>extensive.</p> <p>It is quite easy to meet other language assistants here – I have personally met over 10 other language assistants living here. Also, there is a University of Cadiz campus here and therefore one can also socialise with both the local and exchange students here. There is an organisation called ESN Cadiz which I'd recommend joining for meeting people and getting involved with the activities they offer like international dinners, language exchanges, going out for drinks and trips to other areas around. Depending on where in the centre the flat is located it could take around 15-30 min to walk to school. An alternative could be getting a bike.</p> <p>I have personally never used any buses in Jerez as it is a small city and I walk everywhere on foot. But there is an app called AutobusesJerez where more information on the bus schedules could be found.</p> <p>There is a bus number 4 going to school from the city centre.</p>
